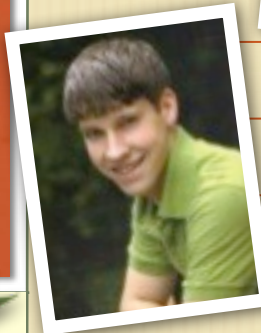

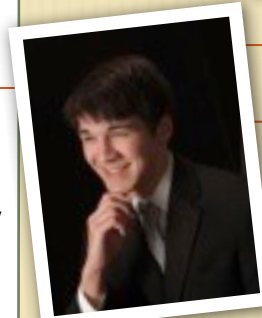

Georgia State Capitol



On Monday, March 8, 2010, we went to the Georgia State Capitol. On top of the building there is a dome with gold on it from Dahlonega, Georgia. The building is 121 years old. In the center of the building is the rotunda, which is a round room underneath the dome. On the walls of the rotunda are portraits of Georgia's governors.

That day the legislature was in session. Representatives were walking up and down the grand staircases. We were able to see into the House chambers where they were voting.

The Georgia Museum is on the second floor of the building. There we got to see many samples of Georgia's animals, fossils, and Native American artifacts.

We visited the Governor's office, even though he wasn't there. The top drawer in the desk has been signed by many governors of Georgia, including Jimmy Carter.
